PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELING

With what concerns can I come for counseling?


We advise you on all study-related and personal difficulties. It doesn't matter whether the problem is small or large, the decisive factor is how important the issue is for you personally. You can make use of our professional help in any case.

When and where does the consultation take place?

The consultation can take place in presence or video-based. From Monday to Thursday, you can register by phone at the secretary's office for an initial meeting. You can then make follow-up appointments directly with your counselor.

Who works at the counseling centers?

Our team in Tübingen and Hohenheim consists of six psychologists and one secretary. In addition to their psychology diploma, all counselors have further qualifications in scientifically recognized psychotherapy methods (psychodynamic psychotherapy, behavioral therapy, conversational psychotherapy and systemic psychotherapy).



How much does a consultation cost?

With us, all consultations are free of charge. At the cooperating counseling centers, up to four sessions are free of charge. All consultations are subject to confidentiality.

Contact and appointment

Contact and appointments with the PBS can be made in person, by telephone or online. For this purpose, we have recently made an appointment [booking portal](#) available on our website. For the initial consultation, a registration form must be filled out. You can obtain the document in our office or download it from our website.

Emergency contacts

In case of acute emergencies or severe mental crises such as suicidal danger, please contact 112 or in Tübingen the Clinic for Psychiatry and Psychotherapy (07071 / 29-82311) and in Stuttgart-Hohenheim to the Furtbach Hospital (0711 / 64650) or the clinic in Stuttgart Bad Cannstatt (0711 / 278278).

At the telephone counselling service you can find a contact person via 0800/111 0 111, 0800/111 0 222 or 116 123 around the clock free of charge and anonymously.

LEGAL ADVICE

On which topics can I get advice?

Our expert will help you with legal problems related to your studies. For example, if you have difficulties with your landlord, questions about exam law, or if you don't get paid for your part-time job.

When and where does the legal advice take place?

Legal counseling takes place by appointment every Tuesday and Friday morning at Fichtenweg 5 in Tübingen. A telephone conversation is also possible by appointment.

Note

The initial legal consultation is free of charge and subject to confidentiality. However, no business services are provided, i.e. neither litigation is conducted nor written pleadings are prepared.

INSURANCES

The Studierendenwerk has taken out various insurance policies. With these, you are insured on the way to the university or home as well as in our and your university's facilities. In the event of a claim, you can contact us directly.

Statutory accident insurance

For accidents during teaching events and on the way to and from the university.

Student accident insurance

For accidents in connection with studies for which the statutory accident insurance does not apply.

Wardrobe and bicycle insurance

Theft insurance; limited to the premises of the universities and the Studierendenwerk.

Household contents insurance

In the dormitories of the Studierendenwerk.
